

# THE MASTERPLAN & PHASES

Erect Architecture have designed an inspired masterplan that allows improvements to the Rec to be co-ordinated, both now and in the future.

## 1. THE COPSE PROJECT

The SSYI has generously donated time and £5k to make a meadow, den building and a willow dome happen!

Also the Co-Op awarded us £1.2k to help create our wild side down by the river and South Cambs have granted us £1k for a bridge over the ditch!



## 2. ENABLING WORK

The Parish Council have set aside £56k to create a new safer pedestrian entrance to the rec & some new car parking, plus a new service point for the Feast's new, more flexible location. There will also be new a new storage area for sports equipment.

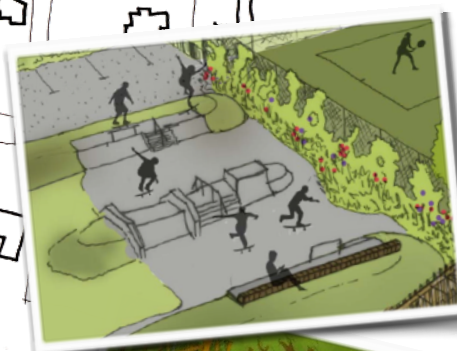


## 3. INCLUSIVE PLAYGROUND

A low level hard landscaped area designed by skateboarding specialists, for both learners and the more experienced to practice their wheel skills.



## 5. BALL GAMES

New combined basketball hoop and football goal, dug into the banking next to the green shelter. Bringing the main play aspects closer together.

## 6. ADVENTURE TREE

Possible future project to add a bespoke, challenging natural climbing structure on the site of the current basketball court.
